The second type of insomnia has physical causes. You may be drinking too much coffee or tea. Even a small amount of coffee can cause insomnia in some people. Your evening meal habits can also affect your sleep. A large meal late in the evening can keep you awake. A lot of alcohol in the evening is also not a good idea. It may help you fall asleep, but later you may not sleep well. Smoking is another habit that can cause insomnia. In fact, the nicotine in cigarettes wakes you up.

In general, you'll sleep better if you lead a healthy life. Exercise is good for your health in general, and it helps you get a good night's sleep. A regular bedtime and waking time are also important. It's easier for your body to fall asleep at about the same time every night.
