## 請閱讀下文,並回答第9-10題

有種說法是「一夫一妻制才是人與動物的差別」,但這樣的說法並不正確,高達90% 鳥類都是單配偶制。不過,近期發表在《皇家學會》(Royal Society journal)雜誌上的新研究,在觀察福克蘭群島15500對信天翁「夫婦」長達15年後,發現全球溫度異常增加,信天翁的「離婚率」竟由1%提升至8%。研究人員稱,這是他們首次記錄具挑戰性的環境因素對信天翁在繁殖過程中所帶來的破壞性影響。信天翁離異,相當於人類婚姻中的出軌,伴侶之一會與其他信天翁交配。目前歸因於兩種理論,第一種理論認為,海水暖化迫使信天翁尋覓食物,必須飛得更遠、更久,不僅增加受傷風險,也使得照顧離鳥工作變得更加艱困,若未能在繁殖季節及時返回,伴侶可能被其他信天翁追走。另一種理論指出,如果環境惡劣,加之食物短缺,信天翁壓力荷爾蒙將會增高,伴侶會認為對方「表現不佳」而相互責備,最終導致離異。該研究的合作者、里斯本大學研究人員文圖拉說,福克蘭群島目前還不用擔心,但信天翁數量有限的地區則令人擔憂。「氣溫在上升,而且還將會升高,因此可能帶來更多干擾。」他說。
