Red Meat, Processed Meat and Cancer

Do you know that eating more than 700 grams of red meat a week increases your risk of colon cancer? Scientific evidence has shown that colon cancer is more common among people who eat the most red meat and processed meat. Red meat includes beef, pork, lamb, and goat. Processed meat is meat preserved by smoking, salting, or adding chemical preservatives. Examples of processed meat include bacon, ham, sausages, and hot dogs. The World Health Organization has classified processed meat as a Group 1 carcinogen (known to cause cancer), which means that there is strong evidence that processed meat causes cancer. Smoking and alcohol are also considered Group 1. Red meat, on the other hand, has been classified as a Group 2A carcinogen, which means it probably causes cancer. There are certain chemicals in red meat and processed meat – both added and naturally occurring – that cause these food to be carcinogen.

To reduce your risk of cancer, it is recommended eating no more than one serve of lean red meat per day or two serves 3-4 times per week. **Cut out** processed meats altogether or keep them to an absolute minimum. A diet of mostly fruits, vegetables and a moderate amount of fish appears to offer the most protection against developing colon cancer. A healthy diet is good for overall outcomes and it is also good for preventing cancer.
