Taiwan offers a great quality of life, but its humid weather can be problematic for those with allergies. Excess moisture in the air can intensify symptoms like sneezing, nasal congestion, and itchy, red eyes.

Pollen, commonly known as the cause of "hay fever," is one of the main triggers of seasonal allergies. Throughout the year—especially in Spring, Summer, and Fall, and even during Winter in some areas—plants release microscopic pollen grains to aid in reproduction. Trees, grasses, and weeds are the primary sources of allergy-inducing pollen. Because their pollen grains are small, lightweight, and dry, they easily become airborne and travel with the wind. Once inhaled, they can provoke allergic reactions in sensitive individuals.

Managing allergy symptoms is possible with a few **practical** steps. One of the most effective ways is reducing indoor humidity, as dust mites flourish in damp environments. Using a dehumidifier can limit their growth and create a more comfortable living space. A nutritious diet plays an essential role in boosting the immune system. Vitamin C is largely used to prevent the common cold, but the intake of all types of nutrients also can be used to strengthen the immune system against allergies. Regular exercise further contributes to overall well-being. Patients can opt for the indoor treadmill or swimming. During high pollen season, the best time to exercise outdoors is during or right after the rain. Following prescribed medications as instructed is also key to controlling symptoms. Additionally, tracking daily activities, dietary habits, and allergy flare-ups in a journal can help pinpoint specific triggers. Since cigarette smoke can aggravate allergies, avoiding both smoking and secondhand smoke is highly recommended. Fortunately, Taiwan's stricter smoking regulations have significantly decreased exposure to passive smoke.

By making a few lifestyle adjustments and maintaining a healthier home environment, you can effectively manage allergies—your eyes and nose will certainly thank you!

The best way to foster a love for reading may lie in pictures. This is the hope of the publishing industry, as sales of children's comics and graphic novels in Britain have reached a record high of nearly £20m.

Publishers are celebrating this trend not only for its success but also for its potential to encourage reading in general. Philip Stone, a media analyst, highlighted the rise of graphic novels for both adults and children. He noted that superhero books remain popular while manga series are also thriving. However, he emphasized the need for more research into whether comics can be a gateway to broader reading habits.

Among the most successful graphic novels are Jeff Kinney's Diary of a Wimpy Kid series and Jamie Smart's Bunny Vs Monkey. Smart believes comics are a powerful storytelling tool, allowing creators to convey character details, emotions, and actions in a visually engaging way. He argues that readers respond positively to this freedom of storytelling.

The demand for graphic books follows concerning findings from the National Literacy Trust, which reported a decline in children's reading habits. Only one in three children aged 8 to 18 said they enjoyed reading in their free time, with overall enjoyment dropping by nearly 9% in the past year. Despite this, Smart remains optimistic, seeing comics as a means of attracting young and reluctant readers with bright visuals and humorous characters.

Meanwhile, fiction sales remain strong across all markets. Best-selling authors include Colleen Hoover, Rebecca Yarros, and Sally Rooney. Fiction hardbacks saw record sales, with six titles selling over 100,000 copies each. Stone attributes this success to affordability and the escapist appeal of fiction. In contrast, non-fiction sales have declined, reaching their lowest figures in two decades. Stone suggests that free online content and reduced interest in personal development books have contributed to this slump. However, religious books are seeing a rise in popularity.

Research supports the idea that comics boost literacy. A study by Manchester University and the Lakes International Comic Art Festival tracked students in a comics literacy program. The group's average reading age increased by 18 months in one year, compared to an 11-month increase in a control group. Additionally, twice as many students in the program listed reading as a favorite leisure activity.
